The Lady Monarchs have maintained their stature by with top finishes in most regattas throughout the fall including the first place at both the Mrs. Hurst Bowl at Dartmouth and the Women's Fingerlake Regatta at Cornell. The women placed second at the MAISA Fall Women's Championship and third at Navy Fall Intersectional. To round out the fall season the women's team place sixth at the Stu Nelson Trophy, the Yale Women's Intersectional and the Women's Atlantic Coast Championship.

With confidence, ODU qualified two women for the USA Laser Performance Women's Singlehanded National Championship.

Mike Martin '88, won the 505 World Championships in 2009. In addition Mike is a nominee for the US SAILING Rolex Yachtsman of the Year to be announced January 2010.

In October, ODU inducted former Assistant Sailing Coach Christine Accutella '94 & '96 into the Sports Hall of Fame. She recently umpired the US Women's Match Racing Championship.
