Posts needing to be filled, BBSA Racing Fleet Captain and Little Creek Sailing Association Representative

BBSA needs a racing fleet captain to replace Scott Almond, who has been at this post as long as I can remember.

Duties for 2013 involved with this post are:

1. Early January - Finalize the Notices of Race for our 4 big regattas and submit to Lin McCarthy. Post these to the website when complete. Coordinate with event chairman (if applicable) or co-sponsor (Little Bay Challenge) for details that belong in the Notices.
 - a. Cape Henry Cup (CHC)
 - b. Little Bay Challenge (LBC)– Portsmouth Boat Club (PBC)
 - c. Cape Charles Cup (CCC) – Hank Giffin, Event Chairman
 - d. Neptune’s Atlantic Regatta (NAR) – Jerry Pattenaude, Event Chairman
2. Provide monthly “department” articles to the Banter promoting upcoming races and racing-related events and reviewing previous races.
3. Attend Willoughby and Little Creek registration nights.
4. Attend organizing meetings for CCC and NAR events to organize on-water race activity support.
5. Mid-April – Set up online registration for CHC and start promoting on the BBSA Facebook page. Recruit PRO (self?), R/C boat, and crew. Order trophies from Tidewater Emblems. Post sailing instructions on BBSA website.
6. May 18th – Cape Henry Cup
7. Mid-June – Depending on negotiations with PBC as to whether BBSA will conduct the race or host the party (to be determined in December/January before the Notice of Race is published), set up online registration and start promoting the race on the BBSA and WR Facebook pages. Recruit PRO (self?), R/C boat, and crew. Order trophies from Tidewater Emblems. Post sailing instructions on BBSA website. If hosting the party, reserve Rebel Marine for event date (January) and throw party.
8. July 13th – Little Bay Challenge
9. August 17-18 – Cape Charles Cup
10. Late August – Set up online registration for NAR and start promoting on the BBSA Facebook page. Recruit R/C boat and crew.
11. September 28th – Neptune’s Atlantic Regatta
12. Late September – Start accumulating and tallying results for the Southern Bay Distance Racing Series. Following ‘Round the Lights Race, complete tally and order trophies from Hi-Tech Engraving.
13. Award SBDRS trophies at annual CCV banquet. Send invoices to participating clubs for their share of the SBDRS trophy money.
14. Work with CBYRA Region IV scheduler (currently Lin McCarthy) to coordinate BBSA’s races on the southern Bay calendar.

Also, the Little Creek Sailing Association needs a new representative to replace John Bergman... who has been at this post as long as I can remember.

Duties involved with this post include:

1. Scoring the races after retrieving the score sheet from RC bag, RC, etc.
2. Maintaining/updating the score sheet (rating changes, new members, etc.), roster, and RC list.
3. Making sure the RC list gets populated for all the weeks.
4. Attempting to resolve protests (twice this year for the first time) when possible before holding a formal protest hearing.
5. Collecting the entry forms and dues and getting them to Jack.
6. Revising the sailing instructions and entry form each year, getting copies made.
7. Ordering RC supplies (horns, tape, flags), keeping copies of the current score sheet in the RC bag, maintain/replace the race course letters.
8. Storing the RC materials (bag, flags, buoy, etc.) during the off season.
9. Calculating the series results, ordering the awards (plaques usually), holding the awards/kickoff meeting, buying the refreshments for the meeting.
