Little Creek Sailing Association is off to another good start this year. We currently have 21 boats registered to race and we have had up to 10 boats racing on a single Wednesday.

In our four other races, we had excellent conditions, plenty of wind and generally calm seas.

We have almost all of our racers using a phone app called Race QS. <http://raceqs.com>. Once you download a Google Earth plug-in to your computer browser, you can re-watch the race and see a great deal of information on your SOG, VMG, heel angle, length of each leg, tack angle, etc. You can compare the information on your boat to the other boats racing that used the app. We are enjoying the race post mortems. Hopefully we will all continue to learn from these debriefs.

The Cape Henry Cup is just around the corner on 16 May, and many of us are looking forward to enjoying the free BBSA membership entry fee.
