## TRAINING SEMINARS

**\*\* US SAILING ONE DAY RACE MANAGEMENT SEMINAR (ODRMS) – Saturday, February 1, 2020, at Norfolk Yacht and Country Club (full day course, 0800-1700). Number of seats are limited, so if you want to go, now is the time to go on line and register.** The registration fee for the seminar is \$35 and includes course materials and online testing. This course is OPEN TO ALL and also meets US Sailing requirements for Club Race Officer certification or renewal. Testing is optional, but required for US Sailing Club Race Officer certification.
