Best Wishes in 2023 from Commodore-Elect Randy Goodman

It is my distinct honor and privilege to serve as the Commodore of the Broad Bay Sailing Association in 2023, as we celebrate our club's 65th Anniversary and we celebrate the 20th running of the Cape Charles Cup Regatta.

I would like to wish all of you a very happy and enjoyable 2023.... Just think, the 2023 Tidewater racing and cruising seasons formally starts in less than 3 months.

As a personal background, I have been racing with the Little Creek Sailing Association since 2006, the same year that I retired from the US Navy. I crewed on Hank Giffin's Coeur d'Alene for five years until I bought a sleek and sexy CAL 34, the Red Frog.

In 2019 I sold the CAL and bought my current boat, a flag blue Sabre 38-2, also named the Red Frog.

Within BBSA, I served as the LCSA coordinator for many years, turning over to Andy Spittler; I was the inaugural BBSA Training Officer, and I have been on the Cape Charles Cup Planning Committee for over 10 years, serving as the registration coordinator and overall event Chairman. As a US Sailing Certified Race Officer, I consider John McCarthy and Scott Almond my mentors.

I am very excited and impressed with the Executive Committee that you elected this year. The 2023 Executive Committee (often referred to as the Board of Directors) is rich with experience, as we have two former BBSA Commodores, Jim DiSomma (2023 Rear Commodore) and Debbie Koelliker (2023 Vice Commodore); Karl Shulenburg (2023 Secretary) is a long time member of this committee and brings wisdom and experience; Larry Baun is very experienced and returning as our Training Officer; After 10 years as serving as the BBSA Treasurer, Sergio Diehl is stepping down to serve as the Commodore of the Hampton Yacht Club (Consider buying Sergio a drink at the January banquet as thanks to his fantastic service to our club). Sergio will be replaced by Rob Williams (another retired Navy guy with a strong financial management background in the Navy and as a small business owner (and his wife Jen is a very experienced professional bookkeeper); New to the BBSA Executive Committee, but with tons of leadership, management experience and time on the water are Claude Speed (2023 Racing Fleet Captain) and David Midkiff (2023 Cruising Fleet Captain). Debbie Koelliker will also serve as the 2023 One Design Fleet Captain.

While not on the Executive Committee, we are blessed to have Eric Brinsfield serve as the lead BBSA Web Coordinator again in 2023.

The 2023 Executive Committee is meeting in mid-January to refine our goals for the year. Some of our 2023 goals include:

- To get as many BBSA members out on the water as feasible – Racers and Cruisers.

- We want to get more BBSA boats racing on the weekends and more people enjoying the beauty and social aspects of Cruising.
- As a carrot, with your 2023 BBSA Membership, you will get 4 free races - The Cape Henry Cup, The Bold Mariner Cup, The Willoughby Memorial Race and The LCSA Veterans Race.
- To grow the stable of BBSA members that are US Sailing Certified Race Officers – BBSA will have more US Sailing Certified Race Officers than any club in Tidewater.
- In 2023 to grow our membership, we would like to welcome and recruit more power boat owners into BBSA, and of course, more sailors.
- Larry Baun and his Training Committee are planning an excellent Winter Training schedule for us...kicking off with the RRS Trivia Night at Bold Mariner.
