RACING NEWS

Well – here we are at about the middle of the season and it's been an interesting year so far. We've had nights with great wind and nights spent bobbing like corks. We've had a number of interesting protests which means that skippers are paying attention to the rules and trying to improve the sport. Some laughter, some tears, some close calls and some dinged boats. All of it interesting. All of it educational. All of it character building.

We've also had several abandoned or cancelled races due to weather. Most of our sailing instructions have guidance language for race committees to the effect that the RC should consider canceling the race if winds are over 20 kts or lightning is imminent. That makes sense from a boating safety perspective, so the challenge is how or when to best make the decision. Some RCs make the decision hours before the race based on forecasts in an effort to minimize inconvenience for crew who have to drive over the HRBT. However, it's been my experience that the weather often splits right at Little Creek and passes to each side of us, leaving ample opportunity to safely sail our courses. We've had personal reports of 5-6 foot waves at the beach off Ocean View only to discover that the waves in the bay were 2-3 feet. So, the rule of thumb for my crews for all races was to make the weather decision at our planned underway time. It doesn't matter which forecasts you use, there's little that will exceed the value of your Mark One eyeball to assess what is really going on at the time you need the information. Worst case - we diverted to a local bar for crew training. Best case - some really great sailing.

The Leo Wardrup Cape Charles Cup is August 18-20. This is one of the most prestigious events of the year and is designed for cruisers who want to experience a challenging race and one of the best social events on the Bay. If you haven't registered yet, check out the [BBSA web site](#) to do so.

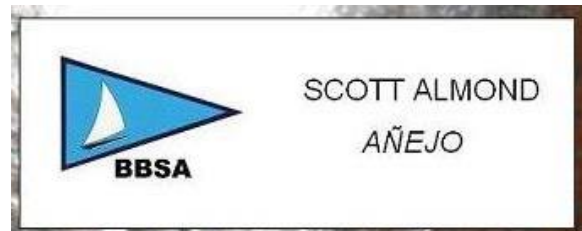
