Hello all, I'm back for another stint as the racing fleet captain. Good to see we have some exciting new things on the docket. Hopefully the weather will warm up soon and we can get our boats ready for the 2024 racing season.

The first big-boat races of the season are about two months away as Little Creek Sailing Association starts their Wednesday Night Series on April 3rd and Willoughby Racers starts their Thursday night series April 4th. Keep your eyes on our website for registration details. We are looking forward to a fun-filled year.

Don't forget to finish up the following applications/renewals before the prep flag drops:

- **US Sailing** – as a member of BBSA, you get a discount on your membership: <https://www1.ussailing.org>. Members also get a free copy of the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- **CBYRA** – become a member for eligibility in their season-long High Point competition; the Southern Bay has its own division (Region IV) for trophies. <https://cbyra.org>.
- **PHRF of the Chesapeake** for your Valid Rating – a necessary evil for racing. Applications and renewals are all done online now: <http://www.phrfchesbay.org/>. Also, please be sure to put BBSA as your primary club.
- **CCV-Racing** – Their racing membership automatically enters you in all of their races for the season (except for Southern Bay Race Week); saves time, money, and headaches!! At least join as a club member to get your copy of the annual racing bible (the CCV-Racing 2024 Guide) to have information on every significant race in this area. Online application is here: <http://ccvracing.us/membership-registration/>

There will be several new classes in the southern bay this year. PHRF has added cruising classes for both spinnaker and non-spinnaker. When getting your PHRF certificate you will see this class. It's free this year and will be added to southern bay races. We will be adding these classes to the BBSA distance races. The former cruising class we had for our distance races will be for skippers without a valid certificate only and boats will be given a curtesy rating.

The ORC class has also changed a little. It will be known as ORC Performance Cruising. If you wish to race in this class, you will need a valid certificate from ORC and they can be reached at <https://orc.org>.

Look for upcoming notices about all of the BBSA and Southern Bay races in upcoming additions of the banter.

After many years, far too many for Andy to remember, he has decided it's time to sit on his arse, show up for races and enjoy the races. Per Andy's own words (that I made up)," I'm tired beating skippers over their heads to get their PHRF Certificates updated and to sign up for Race Committee." Andy's last official act will be to hand out the 2023 awards during the LCSA Kickoff and Award Potluck on 3/16/2024. Please sign up on the BBSA website so we can honor Andy before he fades off into the sunset. The Kickoff will include a short review of SI, the NOR and the 2 new LCSA Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The 2 new rules are as follows:

LCSA RRS#1 - No protests against S/V Set Free will be honored; Set Free is always the Right of Way boat (thanks for the idea, Scott Almond) so it's best to stay aft of their stern and out of their wind.

LCSA RRS#2 - Any boat or skipper that is protested by Set Free is guilty and must purchase beer for the skipper and crew of Set Free at AJ Gator's immediately following the Wednesday night race.

I am excited to take the helm from Andy and look forward to serving my fellow skippers and crew at Little Creek. If you have any ideas for improvement and are willing to help implement those ideas, please reach out to me via email, text, or phone. LCSA is our racing club, and it takes lots of people to make it work so please help out whenever you see an opportunity. You can expect to see the 2024 LCSA NOR out in early February and the SI by late February or early March. Key dates are as follows:

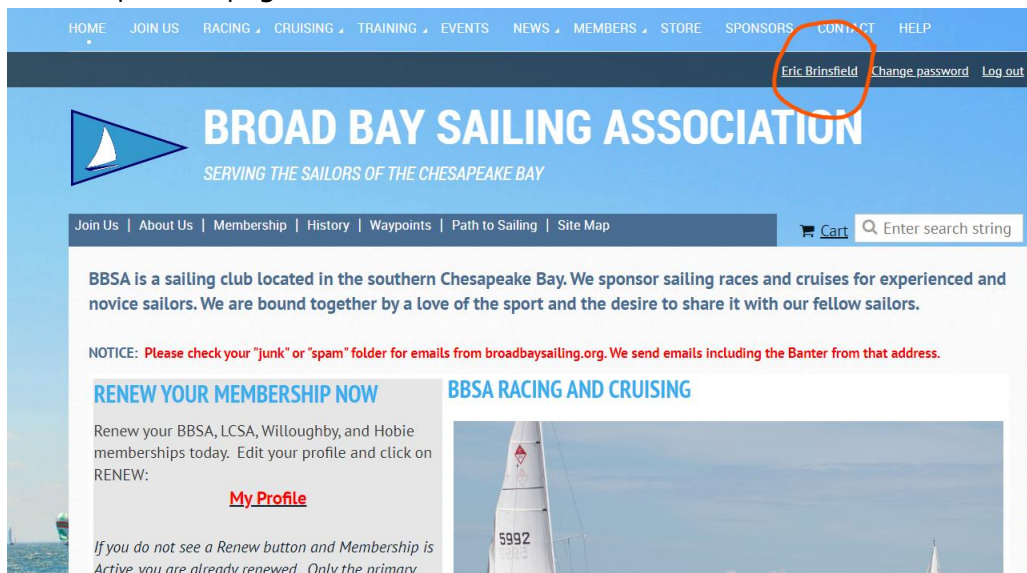
To edit your profile, do the following:

Log In

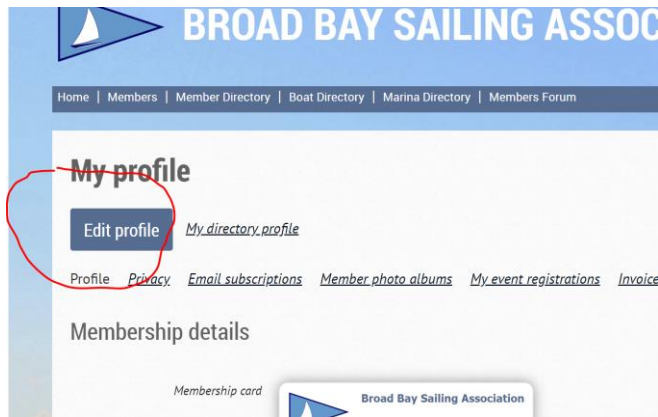
Be sure to log into the website first by clicking on Log In (circled below):

Once in the PROFILE page, click on Edit profile.

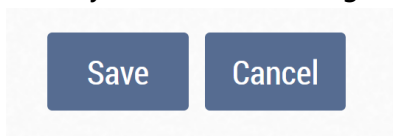


The edit window will open. **WARNING:** After editing, you must press the SAVE button before you leave.
