RESULTS TIDBITS from the 2022 Newport To Bermuda Race. There were 187 boats that started the Newport to Bermuda Race. Among those of particular interest to southern Bay racers were: *NANUQ*, Glenn Doncaster’s Sabre 426, - finished 3rd in class and 17th in the largest division, The St. David’s Lighthouse Division (SDL Div.) (predominately amateur crew and may only be steered by armature) – *Nanuq* sails out of Fishing Bay YC; *CARINA*, MCCurdy & Rhodes, sailed by Rives Potts out of New York YC- finished 1st in her class and 5th in the SDL Div; *CHALLENGE ACCEPTED*, Michael Cummings’ Jeanneau 53, sailing out of Norfolk Yacht &CC - finished 13th in class and 101 in the SDL Div; *KODIAK*, sailing for Navy Sailing (Jahn Tihansky), finished 5th in class and 28th in the SDL Div.; *WASP*, J133, sailing for US Naval Academy Sailing, finished 9th in class and 49th in SDL Div; *DESTINY*, Thomas Stokes’ Pacific Seacraft 37, finished 11th in class and 33rd in the Finisterre (Cruiser) Div. In the Gibbs Lighthouse Division (all-out racing, often crewed by, and may be steered by, professionals), Will Bomar served as Watch Captain on Ken Comerford’s J121 DARK STORM, sailing our of Annapolis YC - finished 3rd in class and 5th in the Gibbs Hill Division.
