The 31st GABOON RACE proved to be bone chillin' and certainly thrillin' in winds that stayed NW between 19 and 25 knots with the highest confirmed gust at 33 knots. "How *cold* was it?" you say. Twenty-one (21) boats left the starting area (Hampton River) in the staggered start race and completed a pre-set 9 nm course, most in record times and many under reduced sail.
