About the only thing that was "as predicted" was that chop resulted from a big ebb into the face of an East breeze. . . but wait, the breeze wasn't supposed to be East, so See, there is more than meets the eye to sailing and doing well in the 'Round the Lights Race. Actually, those who chose to round Thimble Shoal Light first looked pretty smart for a while, but ultimately the boats who rode the East wind to Middle Ground and moderately ebbing current on flat water to Thimble after the wind went North had the best of the day.
