Southern Bay racer TYLER MOORE is 2012 505 NORTH AMERICA CHAMPION! From Scuttlebutt #3684: The 2012 505 North Americans blasted onto San Francisco Bay last week without massive fanfare, with the 31 -boat fleet going about their business on the Berkeley Circle. After 11 races over 4 days (Sept. 20-23), Tyler Moore and Rob Woelfel edged out Mike Martin and Jesse Falsone for the title. Rob Woelfel lives in Tahoe. He and Tyler have sailed together twice before and this was Rob's first win. This is the 4<sup>th</sup> 505 National title for Tyler. The second team from Hampton at the NA's was Henry Amthor and Dustin Romey. They finished in 12th place ahead of some awfully good sailors.

Neptune's Atlantic Regatta: There was rain and then some breeze and then some more rain, but 17 of the 18 boats that started made it to the finish line at 24<sup>th</sup> Street and the Atlantic Ocean. This was a pursuit race, where the fastest boat starts last, giving everyone else a head start. This time it was Christian Schaumloffel's Hobie 33, Mirage, that started last and finished first in 2 hours over the 15 mile course from Little Creek to the oceanfront. <u>Flying Scot Atlantic Coast Championships, Edenton, North Carolina</u>: Three southern Bay teams finished in the top half of the 22 boat fleet. **Len Guenther with John Wake** took 3<sup>rd</sup> overall, **Jay Buhl with Mike Karn** 

finished 4<sup>th</sup>, and **Mark Wensell with Skip Hope** finished 8<sup>th</sup>. All three teams sail out of Fishing Bay Yacht Club, Deltaville.
