THANKSGIVING is this coming Thursday, November 28th. Gobble! Gobble!

NANUQ, COOL CHANGE, and ROUNDABOUT finish first in fleets in the 2013 HYC FROSTBITE SERIES. Twenty-two (22) boats finished at least one race (most finished more) in the "granddaddy" of Frostbites on the southern Bay. Sunday proved too much – too much wind, too much cold, and too much whipped up water – for anyone to be on the race course. Even the resilient Laser Frostbiters organized by Robert Suhay, who race out of the ODC Sailing Center on the ElizabethRiver, cancelled early and stayed home. PHRF B (13 boats) – 1.Rusty Burshell, Cool Change [3-1-1-1]; 2.Ben Cuker, Callinectes [1-4-2-2]; 3.Bill Gibbings, Jonathan [2-2-5-4]. Alan Bomar, Roundabout, was the only boat racing in PHRF C, and was on the course 3 of the 4 races. Principal Race Officer – Brian Deibler; Scorers– Suzanne Hamilton and Kim Deibler.

PHRF Annual Board of Delegates Meeting. At their meeting held on the 16th in Solomons, the PHRF Board of Delegates voted to keep for 2014 the same Region 4 (Southern Bay) PHRF Class Splits as were in place in 2013. Those are: <u>CBYRA Region 4 - SOUTH DIVISION</u>: A-Up to 109; B-110 to 163; C-164 and higher. <u>CBYRA Region 4 - NORTH DIVISION</u>: A-Up to 109; B-110 to 160; C-161 and higher.
