Bob Fleck, residing in Hardyville, Virginia, put his name on the Black Seal Cup winners list for the third time at Southern Bay Race Week this past weekend. Bob, sailing his S2 7.9, Horizon, shared the Cup with Ben Weeks (Rumble) in 2012, the "tornado year", and won it outright in 2013, again with Horizon.
