'Round the Lights Race. *ROUNDABOUT*, **Alan Bomar's J24**, is **Overall Winner of the 2015 'Round the Lights Race.** *Roundabout* was first to finish the pursuit race that saw 29 of the 41 boats entered make it to the finish line. The swift J24 finished a mere 8 seconds ahead of second place finisher *Stardancer* (**John and Bev Blais**). Third place overall was **Tim Savage**'s *Triage*. Series awards will be presented at the HYC Annual Awards Night on Tuesday, December 8, 2015. The Series runs every Sunday through November 22, 2015.
