LAST GABOON ALERT: The 38th Annual GABOON RACE is THIS COMING SUNDAY, December 6, 2015. Sponsored by Hampton Yacht Club – open to all. *Boats must have a PHRF of the Chesapeake valid rating that certifies the boat meets at least the PHRF “Near Shore” Safety Equipment Requirements. HOWEVER, the PHRF crew limitations do *not* apply. *The race is a staggered start (aka pursuit race) that starts and finishes in Hampton River off the HYC docks. The entire race course is within Hampton Roads Harbor. The course is pre-determined and available at registration on race day. The slower boats start first and the faster boats later in the sequence. Each boat has an assigned time. The starting process begins at 1:00pm. *Individual starting times will be posted at the registration table, located in the HYC Dockside Lounge on race day morning. Deadline for entries is 12:30pm on race day, although earlier entry would be appreciated by race organizers. *For information and/or entry contact event chairman, Phil Briggs at 757-723-5477. **ENTRY:** Submit entry form and fee to: Race Committee (Gaboons Race), Hampton Yacht Club, 4707 Victoria Blvd, Hampton, VA 23669. Make Check payable to HYC. (\$25 for USSA members, otherwise \$30.) Standard CBYRA Entry Form.

Early Heads-Up: Make Plans for the DANA DILLON MEMORIAL NEW YEAR'S MADNESS RACE on New Year's Day (Friday, January 1, 2016). Hampton Yacht Club and Old Point Comfort Yacht Club come together to offer this annual event. The 6 mile race is described as "Around Hampton Bar and into the OPCYC Bar". The start is off the HYC docks, 'tween the orange flag and the blue rock on the opposite shore. The finish is between the OPC Marina Pier and G "3" Phoebus Channel. This is a pursuit race, aka staggered start race, i.e. slower boats start first. There is a mandatory Skippers Meeting at 1000 (10:00am) in the HYC Dockside Lounge. Starting times will be assigned. Hot breakfast (opens at 8am) is available, is complimentary for entered skippers, and at a nominal charge for crew and friends. For visiting boats, rafting at the end of the HYC docks for the Skippers Meeting is encouraged. The post-race party and awards presentation begins at 1530 (3:30pm) at the OPCYC clubhouse. Great food and libations are included in the race entry fee for all skippers and crew. Entry fee received by December 28th is \$25 (after Dec 28th, fee is \$40). For info and entry, contact Mark Wolfe at 757-206-7903. All boats Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker and Cruising must meet the PHRF of the Chesapeake Safety Equipment Requirements, Ches Bay category.
