Here is some handy info to use over the holidays, when racing withdrawal symptoms hit:

“Big Boat” racers - The 2016 Southern Bay Racing Schedule is available for both Divisions, North and South. The SOUTH DIVISION (from the York River area through Hampton Roads to eastern North Carolina) and the NORTH DIVISION (Rappahannock River area – YPR&CC, RRYC, and FBYC) schedules are complete. PHRF of the Chesapeake will soon be reminding racers to renew their handicap ratings early. Avoiding the rush means you have your rating in plenty of time for Spring races. US SAILING ONE DAY RACE MANAGEMENT SEMINAR, scheduled for Saturday, February 20, 2016, at Hampton Yacht Club, Victoria Boulevard, Hampton, Virginia, is now open for on-line registration. This is a great course for those interested in learning about race management as well as the US SAILING race officer certification program. The seminar meets requirements for Club Race Officer certification or renewal. Lead instructor is John McCarthy, USSA National Judge and certified Regional Race Officer. The seminar is posted to the USSA calendar (<http://www.ussailing.org/race-officials/become-a-race-official/race-officer-seminar-calendar/>) and registration is now open. Online registration is encouraged.

And, don't forget to go racing!! DANA DILLON MEMORIAL NEW YEAR'S MADNESS RACE on New Year's Day (Friday, January 1, 2016). Hampton Yacht Club and Old Point Comfort Yacht Club come together to offer this annual event. The six (6) mile race is described as "Around Hampton Bar and into the OPCYC Bar". The start is off the HYC docks, 'tween the orange flag and the blue rock on the opposite shore. The finish is between the OPC Marina Pier and G "3" Phoebus Channel. This is a pursuit race, aka staggered start race, i.e. slower boats start first. There is a mandatory Skippers Meeting at 1000 (10:00am) in the HYC Dockside Lounge. Starting times will be assigned. Hot breakfast (opens at 8am) is available, is complimentary for entered skippers, and at a nominal charge for crew and friends. For visiting boats, rafting at the end of the HYC docks for the Skippers Meeting is encouraged. The post-race party and awards presentation begins at 1530 (3:30pm) at the OPCYC clubhouse. Great food and libations are included in the race entry fee for all skippers and crew. **Entry fee received by December 28th is \$25 (after Dec 28th, fee is \$40). For info and entry, contact Mark Wolfe at 757-206-7903.** All boats Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker and Cruising must meet the PHRF of the Chesapeake Safety Equipment Requirements, Ches Bay category.
