Ian Hill and crew aboard, *SITELLA*, his XP44 newly arrived from Denmark, have won the **2016 Down the Bay Race** for the Virginia Cruising Cup. *Sitella* made the 120 nm, non-stop trip from Annapolis to Hampton in 23 hours 16 minutes, and 07 seconds. She was the only competitor to make the trip in less than 24 hours, and won the **Robert M** Gavin Trophy for line honors. Light to moderate air bedeviled the fleet (41 entries / 36 starters) and 10 boats retired either due to conditions or equipment failure. Will Roberts, *Remedy*, J36, took 2nd overall and John and Beverly Blais, *Stardancer*, Bene 36.7, were third overall. *Sitella* and *Remedy* each won their classes, and so did Jamie Shoemaker and Ron Quinn in their J30, *Goes to Eleven*. John Wayshner in his catamaran *Flipper* won the Multihull group and Thomas Orlowski, *Tranquility*, was first among the Non-Spinnaker boats. Hampton Yacht Club and the Storm Trysail Club Chesapeake Station are DTB event organizers and co-chairmen are David McConaughy and Bill Sandberg. SOUTHERN BAY RACE WEEK OPENS THIS COMING Thursday evening (June 2nd), and continues with three days of racing and partying beginning Friday, June 3rd and running through Sunday, June 5th. As of this morning, the fleet stands at 102 boats from around the Chesapeake Bay and beyond. There are three divisions, PHRF (A, B, C, and Non-Spin classes), One-Design (Viper 640, J24, and J24 classes), Cruising (broken into two classes) and, new this year, Multihull. Two DTB boats have earned the **Stick-to-It Award for Racing**. *Flipper*, **John Wayshner**'s G32 catamaran, finished the 120 mile course and won his class, even though both rudders were broken during the race. *Diablo*, **Greg and Carie Cutter**'s Andrews 28 sailing in the doublehanded division experienced a "lower turnbuckle explosion" off the Potomac. The equipment problem caused them to retire from the race, divert to Solomons, hunt down a used turnbuckle, install it, and, after a nap and lunch, proceed to Hampton. KUDOS! Both *Flipper* and *Diablo* will be racing at SBRW.
