PHRF N: 1st–*RESTLESS*, **Jay Thompson**; 2nd–*SEEKER*, **Al Johnson**; 3rd-*MIDNIGHT MISTRESS*, **Jake Brodersen**. CRUISING 1st–*TEMPO*, **Jonathan Romero**. *NOTE*: The number of awards given in each class is determined by the number of boats qualified in the series (entered in the defined number of races).
