2018 CAPE HENRY CUP. It was a damp nineteen (18.9) miles, but at least there was a racing breeze . . . most of the time. Some sails suffered damage in the rain squalls that moved through during the race. And, the current, the weather iffy-ness, and an aircraft carrier all provided "entertainment" for skippers and crew as they came up Buckroe Beach to the finish line off Ft Monroe. The aircraft carrier was the *Gerald R. Ford* (78) slipping out the channel as a number of the Cape Henry Cup boats were finishing. CRUISING (4 boats): 1. *Modus Vivendi*, Sergio Diehl; 2. *Klimax*, Booty Baker; 3. *Tempo*, Jonathan Romero. *Principal Race Officer: Scott Almond; Signal Boat: Eric and Cathy Brinsfield*. The Cape Henry Cup is administered by Broad Bay Sailing Association.

Black Widow, Ken Copeland/Alvin Girardin/Carl Gade, won the 2018 Cape Henry Cup. The Cape Henry Cup goes to the boat with the greatest corrected time differential (figured as a percentage of the first place boat's corrected time) over the second place boat in her class (four boats starting and two boats finishing minimum). Black Widow finished first in the PHRF Non-Spin fleet.

Times Square will never be the same! The *Vortex Get My Boat team* arrived there a weekend ago and was featured on the Sunday "Fox and Friends" TV show. They had their J70 with them and it was displayed outside the front door of the Fox studios. The parking space was made possible by a special parking pass issued from the NYC Mayor's Office.
