THIS COMING WEDNESDAY, MARCH 20, at 17:58 EDT (21:58 UTC) is the VERNAL EQUINOX- SPRING WILL SPRING!!

That's 5:58pm. So, the sun will be over the yardarm and racers should proceed as appropriate.

IT WILL SOON BE SPRING OFFICIALLY (March 20) – **B.O.L.O (be on look out) for SOCK BURNINGS**! The purpose of the sock burning is to garner racing blessings from King Neptune. Pull out or off your old winter socks and brush up on your sock burning etiquette. (1)Since you are dealing with King Neptune himself to make the offering be sure to *bring your own socks* - don't plan on having some provided or on borrowing from a fellow sailor – your socks for your good fortune. (2)Bring wool or cotton socks – the polyester ones tend to be troublesome to burn and messy to clean up - they heat up just enough to become useless for blessings or to wear. (3)When you offer your socks to the fire, do so in a snappy manner – do not dangle the socks over the fire – try to avoid burned fingers or singed facial hair. (4)Keep your request to King Neptune concise and to the point – especially if it is coolish, others will want to warm for a moment by the fire pit, too. (5)And, if you arrive wearing the socks you plan to burn, keep track of where you took off your shoes!
