The next CCVR race will be the Founders Race, August 24<sup>th</sup>.

SCREWPILE Update: After two days of racing in Solomons, the CRUISING DIVISION winner had been determined. Donna DeSteph, Restless, from Virginia Beach (BBSA), won the two race series (1, 3), Alan Johnson, Seeker, from Hampton (HYC) finished 2<sup>nd</sup> (2-2) tied with Restless, and Peter Darista, Bella, of California, MD, finished 3<sup>rd</sup> (4-1) in the 10 boat fleet.
