## Adding Your Spouse or Significant Other to Your Membership

As you may have noticed, we have recently upgraded our website. As a result, the application form is different from the one we used in the past. We no longer ask you for the name and contact info for your spouse or significant other.

Instead, you can add an associate member, such as your spouse, to your membership records after your membership has been processed. You can add them as a member associated with your membership. You should do this if you want the associate member listed in our printed BBSA Roster or if you want other members to be able to contact your associate member. An associate member has a full BBSA membership with all benefits, including access to member-only pages in the website and email notifications of upcoming events. You or the associate member can control what contact info is entered and displayed.

To do this, just log into the BBSA website at <https://broadbaysailing.org/>. Click on your name at the top right of the page:



In the Profile page you will see "Add Member" toward the bottom of the page. Click on that button and add your associate member.
